

Possible South Node Stories

The Nodal Return: the *transiting* NN passes over your *natal* NN (and the *transiting* SN passes over your *natal* SN). Approx. ages **19, 38, 57 and 75**

Opposite Nodal Return: the *transiting* NN passes over your *natal* SN, and the *transiting* SN passes over your *natal* NN. Approx. ages **9, 27, 46, 65 and 83**

This is very connected to the moon, (nodes of the moon) and to Venus. Moon is the direct reflection of the “feelings” of Venus, from an emotional more reactive and conscious perspective

1st House/Aries/Mars

The ultimate desire in this lifetime was freedom. The potential for having to fight for it or for its uncertainty would have been heightened with this position. This would have been lifetimes of having to face circumstances that demanded decisive action typically without enough information to be absolutely confident in that choice. An uncertainty of one's own direction and self. This potentially would have been lifetimes where you were forced to make decisions that also affected others. There may have been so much focus on one's own self reasons for these choices that the souls lesson would be to learn how to balance authority and compulsion. This would be challenges around dominance over a weaker or needier partner or situation. This is a theme of dominance versus subservience, self versus other.

Mars and Aries adds the potential aggressive impulsive or dominant energy that needs movement and action or else one feels restless and vulnerable.

2nd House/Taurus/Venus

The theme of this past life was resources and security through these resources. This could include food shelter finances and basic needs for a life of comfort or even at the base level a life of survival. In prior lives a lack or limitation of these resources would have left significant imprints within ones level of feeling provided for or safe. This would leave a mark of fear self doubt and insecurity upon the soul. This story of resources could be a lack of or having an overabundance of but feeling the financial stress or deception mistrust and manipulations that comes with having over abundance. Conjunct Jupiter could be over abundance, conjunct Saturn could be poverty conjunct Uranus could be sudden unexpected changes from one to the other. An example of this energy could result that in this lifetime regardless of how much abundance and resources you have there could be an underlining feeling of poverty. Connected to Venus this is also about social values belief systems and our feelings that we emanate in preserving what we feel is right or wrong.

3rd House/Gemini/Mercury

This is about fast movement quick thoughts quick mind quick thinking. There is a karmic imprint of nervousness, mentally driven reactivity and moving quickly without thinking beyond the current issue. This is still very survival based. This could be a quick witted individual who would have used this skill potentially for pickpocketing or seizing opportunities before they got away. A potential energy of

manipulation through the quick witted skills of the mind in order to survive or advance in ones self desire 4 validation. This has a definite energy of a socialite or someone who might have even expressed themselves as a fast talker for personal appearances. The genius behind the heist. There is a restless uneasiness within this placement and whether or not it was expressed through overt manipulation or inverted insecurity, this would have been lifetimes of never feeling settled or safe and in a state of mental anxiety. Creating one's own crisis or problems through reactive impulses.

4th House/Cancer/Moon

This can be a challenging position because it can imply lifetimes of complete lack of emotional and nurturing support from a home environment or parents. This could have been lifetimes of devotional loyalty to families in such an unquestionable way that one may have been over or under nurtured by this environment. This is connected to the deep seated needs of security and ones own belief of whether or not one felt safe or not regardless of the environment around them. This is a highly karmic position showing the potential of deep karmic family ties that one is balancing on a much bigger level than just a personal level. This would also be a signature of losing one's own individual identity and overly identifying with a family or group identity. This can also be related to trauma around children In past lives. This could create a deep potential for walling off and blocking off the heart and feeling far too unsafe to reveal one's true feelings to another due to past lives of feeling as though one was not truly valued. Any 4th house 10th house positions also imply power struggles. Inward versus outward, male versus female, family versus society.

5th House/Leo/Sun

This house also as a potential to be connected to children, but tends to be more about trauma during childhood. This may be a house placement that one questions whether or not to even have children in this lifetime. Or the feeling of is it safe to bring a child into the world. This house placement is the higher octave of Aries now being able to shine that self identity to the world. In past lives this may have been played out as repressed or overtly. The potential for overly acting and identifying for oneself and one's own self pleasure and gain, potentially even expressing as the sexually promiscuous person that is creating love affairs for their own purpose and not caring who they hurt in the process. The repressed expression would be lifetimes of having all creativity and sexuality stifled and overpowered in some way in that lifetime where one did not have the ability to be as recognized and seen as they wanted to be.

6th House/Virgo/Mercury

This placement represents slavery, being in service, and burdened by responsibilities. This would have been a lifetime of crisis. This crisis could have been physical emotional psychological or mental. This would have been some lifetime of duty self-sacrifice and humility. It is important that these emotional expressions could have been experienced even in a lifetime of affluent resources. Being the one in the family that felt like the scapegoat or the slave to the rest of the family having to do all the work for everyone else. It's important to note that these feelings do not automatically imply poverty. One would have felt bound or imprisoned too some situation in their life and felt helpless to change their position within it. This would also have a great energy around mind, and one's belief systems. Not being taken seriously or validated. This could also imply lifetimes of major health issues. This could be disease, body deformity or some sort of major health issue in that life that created a major crisis and sense of being a slave to that health issue.

7th House/Libra/Venus

This placement can represent on a deep level relationships in the past that were dominating overpowering or overly identifying the individual to the point where they would have fully lost any self identity. Primarily lifetimes where one would have dedicated their life to a partner or a relationship as their life purpose. This could have been lifetimes as being the other half, such as the wife of a very prominent person, where one would have been identified as the partner to that person rather than as their own individual self. This would have been lifetimes of Not developing oneself or focusing on one's own sole purpose.

8th House/Scorpio/Pluto

this is a very intense placement for the South node because it can imply lifetimes that were quite intense and filled with deception betrayal or drama. This may have been lifetimes of very dramatic endings of life, sacrificing a life for another, having a loved one die in one's arms, or some overwhelming horror that would have left a deep mark upon the soul of fear grief or anxiety. This placement has many different energies to it and can also imply lifetimes of sexuality and utilizing sex for either betrayal or advancement. This can even hold the potential for sexual humiliation rape or molestation. One needs to truly look at other placements in the chart because this can also be an indicator of dark arts or either utilizing dark intentions for some sort of gain or having had dark arts or intentions used upon you in order for advancement or gain of some sort.

9th House/Sagittarius/Jupiter

Lifetimes in the past potentially had the experiences of being over dogmatic and so invested in ones own thoughts or beliefs that one did not open up to or allow new insight into your process for thinking. The energy behind this could have been fighting for one's beliefs or thoughts so much because this was your identity or who you were. This could be religious scientific or educational in any realm of thinking. This sign can also have with it a potential of travel or potentially being in a whole new mind frame in this lifetime such as east versus West. This could be the repressive of being overpowered by a dogmatic thought form religion or state of thinking, or reactive where one may have been the one traveling and conquering other people for your beliefs. it is helpful to contemplate where you feel a deep need to believe in something within this life, Or been blinded by your own zeal. The trauma here is to see where has one identified with one's beliefs more than one's own identity.

10th House/Capricorn/Saturn

This would indicate the potential of past lives holding some sort of position of recognition or power within your group or community. Some sort of prominence in leadership, and even potentially born into this position. This would create a sense of needing or expecting recognition as more of a sense of entitlement or positional right. This could be positions of power within a family, leadership in a community or leadership within politics or business. In any regard there would be a sense of rigidity of having to appear to the public in a certain way, and upholding a certain rigidity or structure within that outward image. As with the 4th house position the 10th house 4th house polarity signify some sort of power struggle and many times this is played out within the family karmic dynamic and potentially with a parental figure such as the mother or the father. the dominant energy of this placement may create a need to have a sense of power or overpower others in order to uphold position or respect, or the inverted or repressive energy may be a sense of unworthiness and fear of responsibility and power yet

underlining this fear would be a sense of wishing for it, And the potential for resentment towards those in positions of power. This can also play out with run ins with authority and the law in this lifetime.

11th House/Aquarius/Uranus

This can be a placement of humiliation and oppression from individual expression. in potential past lives this could be mob mentality, humiliated in front of the crowd , singled out and publicly outed in some way shape or form. Many times these will be lifetimes dealing with barbaric public mind and the anger and aggression that develops in crowd thinking. On a repressive level this can be a lifetime of feeling completely singled out or different from everyone else, Bullied. On a reactive level this could be lifetimes of being part of the mob mentality, losing oneself in a group thinking and not thinking for oneself or having any individualized personality. This could be lifetimes of being part of a group or cult or some sort of organization that brainwashes or dominates the thoughts of its members. This can also play out as politic or country types of thinking, any story where there is US versus them and humiliation, anger, or violence is used, attacking anything that is different.

12th House/Pisces/ Neptune

This is a very unique placement because not only does it have its own vibrations of potential lifetimes of disillusionment, mental disorders, psychological disconnection from the world, a deep sense of overwhelm 4 handling reality or life and turning to any type of substance, or action for checking out even sometimes physically being locked away from the rest of society in order to not participate with the rest of the world. This placement also has a deeply spiritualized connection with a signature of a soul's path moving through all 12 houses into a cycle of completion. This would be accumulation of all past life traumas through all 12 houses throughout many many cycles of reincarnation in order to come to a completion on a soul's journey with this particular path. Many past lives may include being locked away in monasteries or convents or even mystery schools. this would signify in past lives the tendency to be lost in the realm of spirit be the realm of spirit and esoteric or religious importance, or be it the realm of spirit of disillusionment and ungrounded from the material physical reality. The lifetimes would have placed more importance and anywhere other than physical reality many times as a way to get away from the pain and trauma. This would create a potential for harming or neglecting the body as less important. Over venerating the realm beyond this world and becoming disconnected from humanity, true service to humanity, or empathy. This is a potential for a very detached past life due to an overwhelm and a need to check out and get away. Loss of self, And disconnect from The body.
