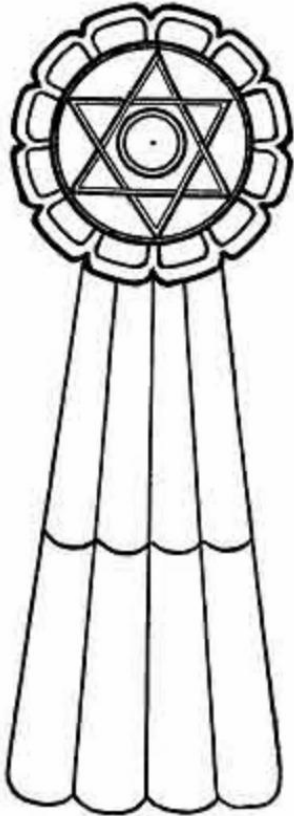


Step by Step Process for Class One

Please take your time with all of this process. As you go through it, if you ever get confused, please always come back to the Gene Key/Gate of the planet you are working with as a way to meditate and contemplate that energy in your life.

Steps

1. Start with going over your Pluto Story in your chart. Here is a basic outline for finding this information

- * Identify the placement of Pluto in your birth chart. This will give you insights into the area of life where you are likely to experience intense transformation and growth.
- * Look at the sign and house placement of Pluto. This will help you understand the nature of the transformation and the specific themes that are likely to emerge.
- * Identify the placement of the South Node in your birth chart. This will give you a picture of the character and theme you acted out in your past life.
- * Focus on the Pluto Polarity Point and the North Node for the “solution” you are seeking to accomplish and be in this lifetime.

JUPITER

Jupiter is where we want to start expanding of expression of “what is....” What is god, the universe, our beliefs, the nature of reality or creation. It want to start expanding to the bigger questions of who we are in the universe.

This expansion can be in thought or study, or through actual travel. Jupiter is very Right Brained. It many times shows past lives in opposite situations, opposite cultures, beliefs, religions, countries, etc

It is the place that we have come to GROW!

The influence of Jupiter in our lives is related to our spiritual growth and expansion. Jupiter represents our beliefs, values, and sense of purpose, as well as our ability to experience abundance and joy.

In past lives, we may have developed limiting beliefs or negative attitudes towards growth and expansion, which can manifest as challenges related to Jupiter in our current life. However, by embracing the positive qualities of Jupiter, such as optimism, generosity, and a willingness to take risks, we can overcome these challenges and experience greater growth and fulfillment.

Ultimately, the purpose of Jupiter's influence is to help us evolve spiritually and connect with our higher purpose in life.

May 16/17, 2023 Jupiter is changing on the from its Year in Aries into Taurus. It will remain here until May 25/26 of 2024 before moving into Gemini.

2. **With the Soul Story in mind, find Jupiter in your Chart.**
 - a. **What Sign is Jupiter in? This is going to show you the generational theme you are playing out. (Look up the Jupiter influences below)**
 - b. **What House is Jupiter in? This is your personal place in this life where you are here to expand and grow. This is the place where you will be drawn to spiritualize or evolve your way of thinking into cosmic questions.**
 - c. **Now notice what Gene Key or Gate is your Jupiter in on your Human Design Chart.**
 - d. **What Center is your Jupiter in on your Human Design Chart? This is the Chakra or energy center you will be experiencing this growth.**

Jupiter - Law & Protection. Other than the Sun, no object exerts greater influence over us. On the Gene Keys path, Your **Design Jupiter represents your Culture, the way you have come to express yourself in this life.** It is one of the three main trigger gates in your design, showing you where you can learn to surrender and to break free from patterns of suffering and victimhood. When we can do this, we then realize your suffering and challenges have been what has helped us to learn and grow and to then be able to be a gift of this healing for others.

It connects to your Design Mars (Core/Vocation) as a way for you to “Initiate” the fire and passion you came to express, and it connects to your Personality Sun (Destiny/Brand/Life’s Work) As a way for you to master your “Path of Growth”.

Your Personality Jupiter is your PEARL. It is the pinnacle of all expression that you came to be in this lifetime, and it can only be realized through the balancing and healing of all other aspects of your chart. It is a lifetime path and place for you to meditate on how you can be your absolute best expression in this lifetime from your Soul Purpose. To learn more about this, you may choose to do follow up session specifically taking your through your Gene Keys path.

Jupiter’s Influence in the Houses

Every separate entity, or individual soul, has been derived from a great oversoul, and although divine in the beginning of its soul at birth, it was destined to descend into denser planes of matter in order to win, through personal effort and merit, it's conscious immortality. (Alan Leo)

The primary functions of Jupiter from a soul centered perspective is to create fusion. It is instrumental in blending the lesser dualities of head and heart mind and love in order to produce wisdom. It is a primary focus for the energies of the ray of love wisdom, and acts as a vehicle through which the ray of consciousness may externalize the divine plan in our solar system. (Alan Oken)

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Aries/1st House/Mars

gives a consistent sense of inner and personal revelation of the underlining concepts behind objective manifestation. There's a great urge to teach and share and to stimulate perspective perception from one's personal revelations and concepts.

Here Jupiter's is focused on our individual identity and self-expression. This placement encourages us to take risks, be adventurous, and pursue our passions with enthusiasm and confidence. We may feel a strong urge to assert our independence and explore new ways of expressing ourselves.

However, there can also be a tendency towards impulsiveness and recklessness, as we may be more inclined to act before thinking things through. It's important to be mindful of our actions and decisions during this time, as they can have a significant impact on our future growth and evolution.

Jupiter in Aries brings a cooperation of the instinctual desire nature and the intuitive capacity to generate an expansion of one's understanding of the universal laws that govern life on this planet. The function of Jupiter strives to comprehend the individual's place in the greater scheme of things. As it is combined with Aries, this creates a moment to moment dynamic where the individual will feel there is some special knowledge to discover and feel an instinct to act or pursue where its instincts direct it. Jupiter in Aries requires total freedom and independence to act on and pursue questions relating to the nature of the Universe, and how the individual fits into it. It generates an instinctual feeling that there is something special for the individual to discover, which will explain or reveal one's place within the natural web of life, where everyone and everything has a purpose and a reason.

Taurus/2nd House/Venus

has a need to expand material possessions ease and luxury, but on a sole centered level it can begin to Blend choose the realms of nature and work more in harmony with what is required rather than desired

When Jupiter is in Taurus or the 2nd house, there is a strong desire to accumulate wealth and material resources, and to create a sense of stability and security in our lives. This placement encourages us to take a practical approach to our finances and to focus on building a solid foundation for our future.

However, there can also be a tendency towards attachment and possessiveness, as we may become overly focused on our possessions and material wealth. It's important to cultivate a healthy relationship with money and resources during this time, and to avoid becoming too attached to material things.

The influence of Jupiter in Taurus is to bring to life an absolutely essential part of their natural selves: their natural roots as they are preserved by Mother Earth. 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Gemini/3rd House/Mercury

On a soul level it is best to continuously stay within the students mind leaving oneself open to continual or new possibilities.

Jupiter in Gemini or the 3rd house can influence creative thinking or the creative impulse to self-actualise reflected by a distinct assembly of mental connections. It can also influence the exploration and experimentation of new careers, studies, or lifestyles. Additionally, it can encourage an appreciation of diversity and the interconnectedness of all things.

When Jupiter is in Gemini or the 3rd house, there is a strong desire to expand our knowledge and understanding of the world around us, and to engage in meaningful conversations and connections with others. Cancer/4th House/Moon

When Jupiter is in Cancer or the 4th house, there is a strong desire to create a sense of emotional security and stability in our lives, and to nurture ourselves and those around us. This placement encourages us to develop a deep connection to our roots and to our family history, and to create a safe and supportive home environment.

However, there can also be a tendency towards emotional dependence and clinginess, as we may struggle to let go of the past or to separate ourselves from our family and home environment. It's important to cultivate a healthy sense of independence and emotional maturity during this time, and to avoid becoming too attached to our past or our emotional patterns.

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Leo/5th House/Sun

My soul centered perspective the sun creates a very potent energy to help fuse the will, the mind and the creative expression into love and wisdom. Virgo/6th House/Mercury

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Libra/7th House/Venus

We're not doing so in a way that is a detriment – that's a learned guilt that there's something wrong with us – it's more integrating these things in a way that helps us mature, and in the end helps us develop a level of authenticity that we can then express in the world, whether it's through teaching (Jupiter), through humor, or through natural methods such as taking care of the Earth, etc. There is an opportunity for growth and expansion through hard work, discipline, and a commitment to achieving one's goals and ambitions in a way that aligns with their personal values and beliefs.

Pisces/12th House/ Neptune

 - b. Now, what Gene Key / Gate is your Neptune in on your Human Design Chart?**
 - c. What Center is that Gate in? This is the Chakra/energy you are spiritualizing most from in this life.**

Neptune Generations

From a soul centered perspective Neptune is the most spiritualized and has the most influence in one's life. Neptune is the expression of the heart of the spiritual Sun within our solar system and is the vehicle for Christ consciousness.

Libra

(1943-1957) Neptune in Libra generation signifies the projection of self sacrifice and devotion into the interpersonal dynamics of life. For those on the spiritualized path, this is almost an entire generation of “relationship counselors” Who work at trying to create a science of relationship through connection that will serve humanity.

Scorpio

(1956-1970) This generation is here to develop the correct use of sexual energy and the transformation of the lower worlds. This will also create a draw towards the astral plane and the centering of emotions through the

solar plexus. This generation is going to be working out an important collective karma of flushing out the lower worlds and being the rebirth of expressing the Christ self over from the lower self's desires.

Sagittarius

(1970-1984) This generation we'll have very profound and religious or philosophical beliefs. There will be an inner need to practicalize these understandings and find a way to infuse them with love and wisdom in order to integrate them into the forms of daily life. There can be an impulse towards being emotionally charged. Or even the urge for self sacrifice. Overall the desire is to infuse spirituality or a sense of purpose back into the world.

Capricorn

(1984 – 1998) This Neptune generation is in a fall position. The energy between the soul and the ego could not be more different. This will be a potential generation of people who are totally fooled by matter and intoxicated by form and swept up into the urge of personal power. Love can be restricted by this veil of desire for personal power and amassing individual resources. On a soul level this generation will be called to learn to infuse love back into physical form. Aquarius

(1998-2012) this generation will be pulled towards a great influence of scientific achievement. Pisces

(2012-2026) from a soul centered perspective this placement housed the potential to create the many lovers and saviors of humanity. This could truly be the army of Christ. The last time this placement occurred once in 1849 to 1862. It coincided with the last degrees at the end of American slavery and the civil war. with Neptune in pisces this soul centered individual can embody a loving devotion towards right action. On the shadow side there is a potential for false prophets and messiahs. These individuals have a very magnetic energy that they will express through their solar plexus. This generation has the potential to do great good for the planet or great harm. The ultimate contribution will be the glamour and illusion of their work that will be revealed as the veils are lifted. The potential here is humanities quest for the spiritual truth inherent in love and wisdom.

URANUS

Uranus is the Higher Octave of Mercury, and is Directly connected to chasing and shattering Saturn. This is the planet of Transformation. The place where spirit breaks free from any structures or restraints that are outdated or do not flow with the harmony of the Soul.

When Uranus is in Retrograde, it opens the Door for Neptune

This is how our soul is breaking down the false that is in the way of transformation. It is the breaking down of our conditioning.

In human design, the experiment is all about deconditioning. Uranus is deconditioning at its' fullest expression.

Uranus correlates to individuation, liberation, freedom, and deconditioning. Deconditioning from what? Deconditioning from Saturn. Saturn correlates to all the conditioning patterns of our life. the conditioning patterns of society, family, expectations of people in our lives, and the conditioning patterns relative to all the prior lives that you bring into this life. All that conditions your sense of identity at any moment in time. Uranus clearly is an antithetical archetype to Saturn. This means that Uranus is forever trying to shatter, revolutionize, liberate, or break free from all those conditioning patterns. What for? What is the intent? To what purpose? If we shatter all the conditioning patterns that define our sense of personality and identity then we can, at some point, arrive at our essential nature and identity that is unconditioned. Obviously, that can be a fairly long journey.

In Evolutionary Astrology, Uranus is a trauma signature. This is because Uranus is considered the higher octave of Mercury, which pertains to the lower mind or short term memory. Uranus then represents the higher mind, or long term memory, reaching so far back that it's actually able to give us an idea of difficulties we may have faced in the past. We may not remember, but Uranus does and typically responds well to meditation and regression. And because karma is considered to be a series of patterns, these traumatic themes are likely to play out in our lives at one point or another. There could be subconscious fears or issues surrounding the archetypal themes Uranus embodies in our chart, and this can go so far as to create triggers, much like a form of PTSD. When looking at Uranus in a chart, it's important to consider the sign, house and aspects it's making to other planets, namely the conjunction, square or opposition. (Sources: Uranus: Freedom From The Known by Jeffrey Wolf Green and Healing The Soul by Mark Jones.)

The house that Uranus is in shows us our shadow, our past lives energy we came here to dissolve the delusion of, so we can embrace Source, which is right inside of us.

The house that Neptune is in shows us where we need to surrender, the house where Uranus is in, is where we need to break free.

Uranus shocks us, the revolutionary energy that helps us break down the false. Almost as if it holds a charge to it that electrocutes us if the energy it touches as it moves, does not resonate with our Soul Source truth.

We are hardwired to not feel comfortable with things (energy) that goes against Natural Law and Source of All that Is.

Uranus correlates to the hypothalamus. We all have one. It is located in the lower brain, in the back of the skull, and emits what are known as chemical messages which are impacting on the primary brain, the

instinctual brain, which regulates all body functions like breathing, excreting, the sexual impulse to procreate the species, etc.

This is a visual way to start to see your Soul Journey in this lifetime.

Uranus will stay in one House for Approximately 7 years.

Uranus has an 84 year cycle, and Saturn has a 28 year cycle.

It takes three complete Saturn cycles to equal one Uranus cycle.

Saturn transits each house or life issue every two and one-half years, **while it takes Uranus seven years to move the same distance. In seven years, therefore, Uranus has moved through one house and Saturn, three.**

Uranus induces the need to be free from that which is, the freedom from the known, at 21, 42, 63, & 84

Your Uranus Opposition will occur around the age of 42 to 44 yrs.

This is your Kundalini Awakening and can be seen as your “midlife crisis’ The house of your Uranus, and Uranus Opposition show the places your are seeking freedom to be ALL of you. Any places you have been holding yourself back, or have not retrieved all the gifts from your shattered shadow self (traumatized inner child/soul retrieval), you may feel the rebellion acting out to be free.

Next Step...

4. **With the Soul Story in mind, find Uranus in your Chart.**
 - a. **What Sign is Uranus in? This is going to show you the generational theme you are playing out. (Look up the Uranus influences by house and sign below)**
 - b. **What House is Uranus in? This is your personal place in this life where you are here to witness the pain and traumas of the past. This is the place where we will feel were Soul “kundalini” is restricted, and Uranus will light that up for us so we can release these blocks through mindfulness.**
 - c. **Now notice what Gene Key or Gate is your Uranus in on your Human Design Chart.**
 - d. **What Center is your Uranus in on your Human Design Chart? This is the Chakra or energy center you will be called to heal in the a major way.**

Aries/1st House/Mars

(Uranus) Trauma related to individuality, self-expression, and identity. This could include experiences of rejection or feeling like an outsider. Here there is trauma on an instinctual, bodily level and is not necessarily rational. This can indicate some type of physical struggle, violence, sexual violence or overexertion. There’s a strong need for freedom and a sense that the will has been thwarted in some way. There could be subconscious memories of having died young, which can cause the individual to push themselves physically or sexually, trying to overcome a feeling of being ineffectual or having been cut down in their prime.

Taurus/2nd House/Venus

(Uranus) Trauma related to self-worth, material possessions, and security. This could include experiences of financial instability or loss of resources. Here one has a narrowing of the self, as if the person shuts themselves off from other possibilities before those possibilities have even occurred. This is because they've experienced a loss of security and have been met with famine, lack of resources, sexual assault, perpetual anxiety, or mass catastrophe. They subconsciously fear the loss of self that comes from being reduced to survival mode. As a self-fulfilling prophecy, the life experience is reduced as they build a wall around themselves out of fear and seek to fulfill their own needs in a very narrow way that leaves no room for possibility or anything "new." There could be a subconscious aversion to intimacy (an indicator of sexual assault) and they may struggle to open up to others as a result.

Gemini/3rd House/Mercury

(Uranus) Trauma related to communication, learning, and siblings. This could include experiences of difficulty in communication or feeling a lack of support from siblings. Trauma occurs when others contradict or disagree with their viewpoint. There may be memories of alienation, imprisonment or having been tortured for speaking their mind, seeing a political or cultural conflict differently, or being the messenger of news no one wanted to hear. Trauma can also occur through siblings in the form of incest, bullying or opposing viewpoints. They may feel trapped in a narrative or a pattern of thinking, often feeling intensely victimized by things others have said or done to them. Over time this narrative can become deeply toxic and re-traumatizing to the point where even talking about the trauma can feel frustrating because they've already exhausted themselves analyzing it.

Cancer/4th House/Moon

(Uranus) Trauma related to family, home, and emotional security. This could include experiences of instability or disruption in the family or feeling a lack of emotional support from caregivers. Traumatic fragmentation and dissociation within the inner child. This indicates very difficult family experiences and a core wounding to the emotional body. In this instance the family itself will mirror past life experiences, playing out a narrative drama the individual has gone through themselves in order to help the child learn and grow. Uranus here can indicate intense losses that have shattered the emotional body and sense of safety in the form of intense abandonment from loved ones. There could have been violent separations through war or betrayal, having been taken away from the family or given up for adoption. Either way there has been a theme of separation, lack of nurture, or difficulty with the mother or caregivers in past lives and as a result this person will have unmet childhood needs.

Leo/5th House/Sun

(Uranus) Trauma related to creativity, self-expression, and children. This could include experiences of rejection or feeling unsupported in creative pursuits or difficulties with children. Trauma occurs when the person realizes they are unable to create from a highly inspirational place at all times and burn themselves out. There can be a sense that their creativity has been hurt or damaged in some way or that they're dissociated from it.

They may have thrown themselves into one too many situations that didn't work out, and feel crushed, futile or depressed as a result. There could be memories of aristocracy or a certain amount of artistic achievement that brought them money, power or prestige. There may be memories involving the loss of such power and a sense of having fallen from grace. Their creativity may have been met with hostility by others capable of inflicting great damage on the individual and as a result they can feel intensely traumatized if their creative contribution to life is not acknowledged, or worse, is negatively received. There could also be memories that involve the loss of a child or difficulty with children, which could make them particularly averse to the idea of being a parent.

From a Soul Centered perspective the intense self-conscious focus of Leo must be focused on the group and the group purpose. This allows the energy of Uranus to help contribute to the collective through creativity and love.

Virgo/6th House/Mercury

(Uranus) Trauma related to work, health, and service. This could include experiences of burnout or illness related to overworking or feeling unfulfilled in work. The individual has desired to understand themselves and the nature of other people in a humble way. Unfortunately this has manifested as intense critical feedback from others and that feedback being deeply internalized. The mind runs like tape loops of negative thoughts and there's a considerable amount of effort applied in finding evidence of why they're shameful, bad, or why other people don't like them. Without learning self-acceptance they will continuously struggle to quiet their anxiety and go out of their way to prove their own guilt.

From a Soul Centered perspective, Virgo will create an urge to improve the standards for humanity and the ability to see truth beyond the material form.

Libra/7th House/Venus

(Uranus) Trauma related to relationships, partnerships, and projection. This could include experiences of betrayal or feeling unsupported in partnerships. Traumatic separation or termination of relationships that were experienced as shattering due to codependency. Because they believed they needed these individuals, once they died or left there was a feeling of having been cut off from what was considered joy in life. There has been excessive codependency in the past, an over-definition of the self through others. More weight has been given to how others see them versus how they see themselves. Trauma through having been disappointed and let down by others or a feeling that their true potential was never acknowledged by them.

From a Soul Centered perspective you hold a deep resonance with fairness, balance and the ending of wars. There is an urge for peace and love. Your Soul is on a path of embracing and being, and then sharing the vision of world unity and freedom. Remember to share the laws of one and unity consciousness from love, not rulership or dogma.

Scorpio/8th House/Pluto

(Uranus) Trauma related to power, intimacy, and transformation. This could include experiences of loss or betrayal in intimate relationships or feeling a lack of control over one's life. Trauma through relationships experienced as conflict. There is a sense of having been used or abused by others. Because of an intense desire to be close to other people, they may have found themselves soulfully engaged with another person only to feel a tremendous sense of betrayal once that person suddenly turned away from them or began acting selfishly. They could have been betrayed by a friend, lover, family member, or anyone they believed to be a trusted confidant. The overall experience has been one of psychological power dynamics prevailing over love and friendship. There could possibly be memories of destruction, the torturing and killing of someone close to the individual or perhaps they were the victim themselves and were utterly destroyed by someone they once trusted.

From a Soul Centered perspective, this is the placement of magic and the cycles of death and rebirth. This is the struggle of the interplay between spirit and matter. The polarity point of Taurus gives the perfect learning ground for detachment and ascension through the spirit. This is also connected to sexual energy and sacred right use of it. The path of Uranus in Scorpio is about the sacred rituals and practices that free the spirit from being bound to physical form.

Sagittarius/9th House/Jupiter

(Uranus) Trauma related to beliefs, higher learning, and travel. This could include experiences of feeling trapped in belief systems or feeling disconnected from spirituality. The individual's beliefs, vision of reality, or view of the world religiously or culturally has been the source of trauma. They may have been fundamentalists or died in a religious war. There's a tremendous fire and purpose and a tendency for the person to want to do it all, but at some point they may have become messianic or over-driven. Ultimately it's the way the individual has seen themselves fitting into all of life that has caused trauma.

From a Soul Centered perspective, this placement is an energy of being here to change and teach new laws and principles for the evolution of Humanity. There is a strong draw towards philosophical motivation in order to help build a better world. You will have an ability to use your path in life and the challenges you have lived in order to help create new archetypes for humanity to step into. It is important to keep a balance with logic and the heart in order to not put too much emphasis on the personal knowledge. How can you awaken the path of learning and knowing within others?

Capricorn/10th House/Saturn

(Uranus) Trauma related to career, status, and authority. This could include experiences of feeling limited or suppressed in one's career or feeling a lack of recognition. The way the individual is perceived by society, religion, their parents, or any situation in which authority applies itself judgmentally has been a source of trauma. There may be memories of being born into very cold family situations in which duty, devotion to order and social standing took precedence over love and understanding. There may also be memories of intense persecution or imprisonment from society or political regimes for not fitting in or having acted in a rebellious way. A sense of having to "follow the rules" could invoke anxiety due to memories of having been

punished for breaking them. There's a certain futility or despair in regard to following the rules since in certain families or totalitarian regimes, these rules could have changed frequently. Because of this, these people crack under societal pressure. Whether it's filling out medical forms or applying for a job, these day to day societal customs evoke memories of such regimes or dysfunctional families in which power was used abusively. In this life or other lives there is a theme of having been at the mercy of insecure, absent, tyrannical or bullying fathers, bosses, and political figures. People who wielded their power and authority without empathy and mistreated others as a result.

From a Soul Centered perspective, if you are born with this placement in your natal chart, you will be very form conscious. Uranus in Capricorn creates an energy to seek to restructure society at its roots and foundations. The Soul Centered goal will be to put these new forms into action from ones own unique vision of a new world order of social improvement. There is a strong desire with this placement to for personal power, and perhaps even a certain ruthlessness in their urge to achieve the desired envisioned positions of leadership that will help you accomplish the goals you see for the future. Your gift to humanity will be in creating a new movement on the planet which will very much condition, and set the foundation for, the next seven years influenced by the new ideas and inspirations of Aquarian energy.

Aquarius/11th House/Uranus

(Uranus) Trauma related to community, social groups, and future goals. This could include experiences of feeling like an outsider in social groups or feeling disconnected from future goals. Here there is tremendous dissociation, as if the self has become a fragmentary identity. Trauma occurs when the individual has reached some kind of recognition that the way they're living is not true to their own nature or who they really are. When they have recognized that there are parts of them that aren't real or are distortions, fictions made up about the self in order to protect against the vulnerabilities of life.

From a Soul Centered perspective, having your Uranus in this placement on your chart means that you have come to this Earth when there is a tremendous amount of turmoil and world change. Uranus brings new ideas, innovation, new technologies and science. You have come to be an innovator of new energy on the planet. This means using your heart to help initiate the new beliefs and ideas that will usher in the new. This may make you feel like an outcast or different than others, but when you move away from the ego and into the Soul's perspective, you will find the strengths in your unique energy you have come to share with humanity. We are a human species as a whole, and our path is to be evolving not only in material (technology) but in spirit.

Pisces/12th House/ Neptune

(Uranus) Trauma related to the unconscious, spirituality, and self-sabotage. This could include experiences of feeling lost in the unconscious or feeling like one's spiritual beliefs are not supported. Trauma often accompanies a sense of being overwhelmed by larger forces. This can cause distressing inner states of futility, meaninglessness, and feeling victimized or attacked by life. It can also correspond to certain psychological states of imprisonment or enslavement, or even chosen imprisonment.

Polarity One: 1st and 7th Houses The first polarity turns around the issues of self/other. Am I deeply immersed in myself and not relating to others? You are more in a relationship than you could ever be on your own, and the qualities you acknowledge in yourself are not prideful. You see your own beauty by observing yourself in another. You see the magic in your other side, which frees you from the gripping expectations you’ve secretly had of yourself ever since you can remember. You’re bored with all those unattainable ideals that somebody projected onto you long ago. All that is left is fascination with the awesome energy you find in others. You are waves of love and light in the universe! As this multidimensional sense of self awakens, new levels quicken in your relationships. Your partner simultaneously sees your vibrancy and basks in wonder.

Polarity Two: 2nd and 8th Houses The second polarity turns around the issues of grounding and emptying. Am I stuck in a house in the midst of a fifteen-year accumulation of possessions and feeling like I can never leave? Or have I so let go of things I need for living that I am not grounded? Resolution: higher ethical sensitivity. Take for yourself what you really need from the Earth and enjoy all your pleasures. Let go of every single thing in your life that is not frequently needed or used. Teaching: the Native American saying “The Earth is your Mother and she freely offers to you all that you need.”

This polarity is about the mastery of the experience of grounding and emptying occurs once you’ve made home on Earth. Whether you move about with just a knapsack on your back or dwell in one home and never leave it, wherever you are, you are grounded and vibrate with the center of Earth. As you exist profoundly intermeshed in the planetary fields, you do not allow things into your space that distract you from the planetary pulse. This focus links you into the Galactic Mind, an empty space holding Earth in form—Gaia. Once you attain this linkage—which is based on grounding and letting go of anything that is not needed in order to stay in form—you discover how to circulate this field by using thought to manifest things. Since you are clear about what you really need, you keep it just by paying attention to it. You eliminate things that are extraneous or intrusive. With no junk in your space, you visualize what you need, and it appears within a matter of time assuming you still want it. This is co-creation with the divine.

Polarity Three: 3rd and 9th Houses The third polarity turns around the issue of integrating in ordinary reality and connecting with spiritual realms. Am I so hooked on my computer, fax machine, telephone, and plane flights that I haven’t had a mystical thought or feeling in months? Or am I so spiritually obsessed that I can’t stand ordinary reality, which is falling apart because of my lack of attention to details? Resolution: integration of self as vessel of spirit. Find the spiritual dimension daily within every act in your life. As you meditate,

connect everything you feel and know with everything and everyone in your life. Teaching: the Zen Buddhist saying “With right words and actions, spirit resides in the heart.”

This polarity is about the mastery of self-integration in ordinary reality and connection with spiritual realms occurs when you can feel the spiritual flame that exists in the most ordinary and mundane things in life. For years you’ve learned the tricks of how and when to be totally in touch with your primary contacts. You know how to respond quickly and effectively when you are really needed; otherwise, you are free from physical linkages. You travel freely in many nonphysical zones by means of clairvoyant, clairaudient, and clairsentient skills. When intelligences that can assist you are nearby, you see, hear, and feel them. You live in ordinary reality in total contact with unseen worlds that are the source of higher guidance. In ordinary reality, rare breakthroughs—such as a deep conversation with an ancient, wise relative or a chance encounter with a long-lost friend—link you with awesome spiritual forces crossing chasms of time and space. With this penetrating awareness, you hear exactly what someone is saying to you when they are speaking to you.

Polarity Four: 4th and 10th Houses The fourth polarity turns around the issue of inner knowing and outer power. Am I so deeply involved in my home or inner subconscious exploration that I am disempowered in the world out there? Or am I so involved in power struggles that I have forgotten exploration of my inner world? Resolution: inner energies create outer reality. Here you explore your subconscious, come to know your shadows, and find respect for the power of inner urges. As you revel in exercising power in the world, in freely giving of your personal power, you recognize that everything you know comes from the pool of all the desires and visions of Earth and its inhabitants from the beginning of time. Teaching: the New Age saying “You create your own reality.”

This polarity is about the mastery of inner knowing and outer power exists when you can read someone else’s reality just by going into yourself and observing your own responses. You don’t have to examine outer forces to know about anything; you feel the vibrations of others within your body. When you are in a power role, you can read any situation by observing energy coalescing around desires: you see things moving in and out of form to know what to align yourself with. As for your powers, they activate when situations offer new insights that ignite your passion. You immediately drop any pursuit that drains your energy. Moving through scenes without being noticed, realities shift when you pass through.

Polarity Five: 5th and 11th Houses The fifth polarity turns around desires and giving away. Am I so involved in my creativity that I pay no attention to giving to others? Or am I giving everything all day to people who need me and paying no attention to the needs of my inner child? Resolution: playing creates service. As your child within plays and creates, you then know how to give from that wellspring of delight. Teaching: the creation spirituality saying “As the Divine plays, God/Goddess creates through humankind.”

This polarity is about the mastery of your desires and giving away your gifts enables you to consciously participate in the creative flow of the universe. You manifest realities with pure intention because nonphysical beings participate in your creations. You open the world to these energies and invite them in to play with you. By making pillars of light in Earth, you open the vertical axis that circulates energy from one reality to another, thus new intelligence arrives. You see creation as it occurs and shape it into tangible things. As you create

visuals of things in your mind, they take form, just like a painter creates images on canvases. Creating with thought is palpable.

Polarity Six: 6th and 12th Houses The sixth polarity turns around being in the moment and letting go into divine fusion. Am I so obsessed with my responsibilities that I have lost contact with spirit? Am I so involved in mystical contemplation that I am not existing in the moment, in ordinary reality? If Spirit walked in the back door of my house or filled my car with gas, would I see her/him? Resolution: be here now. As you fulfill your duties, notice how absolute focus moves you right into deep cosmic joy. As you contemplate the Divine, notice how it is most easily found in the smallest and most obscure places. Teaching: from the mythological centaur Chiron, “In the energy of each moment the divine exists.”

This polarity is about the mastery of being in the moment while merging into the divine fusion occurs when you are totally aware in ordinary reality and blissed out. This state opens extraordinary perceptual skill; while you're in this state, things are timeless and you notice minute shifts or change in your reality. Things and people are always changing, but you actually notice these changes right when they happen. Your own body has always been your best teacher, and you can actually feel viral or microbial invaders. You work with them and rarely get sick except when they have something to teach you. As you watch things manifest, you see the actions of the Divine Mind.

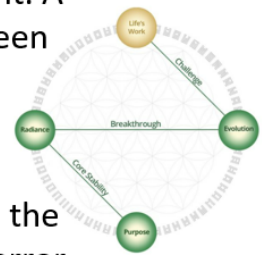
Sun Lines – Inner House - Personal

1 – The Creator - Higher Service Keynote: Stabilizing - You are here to change the way people breathe
