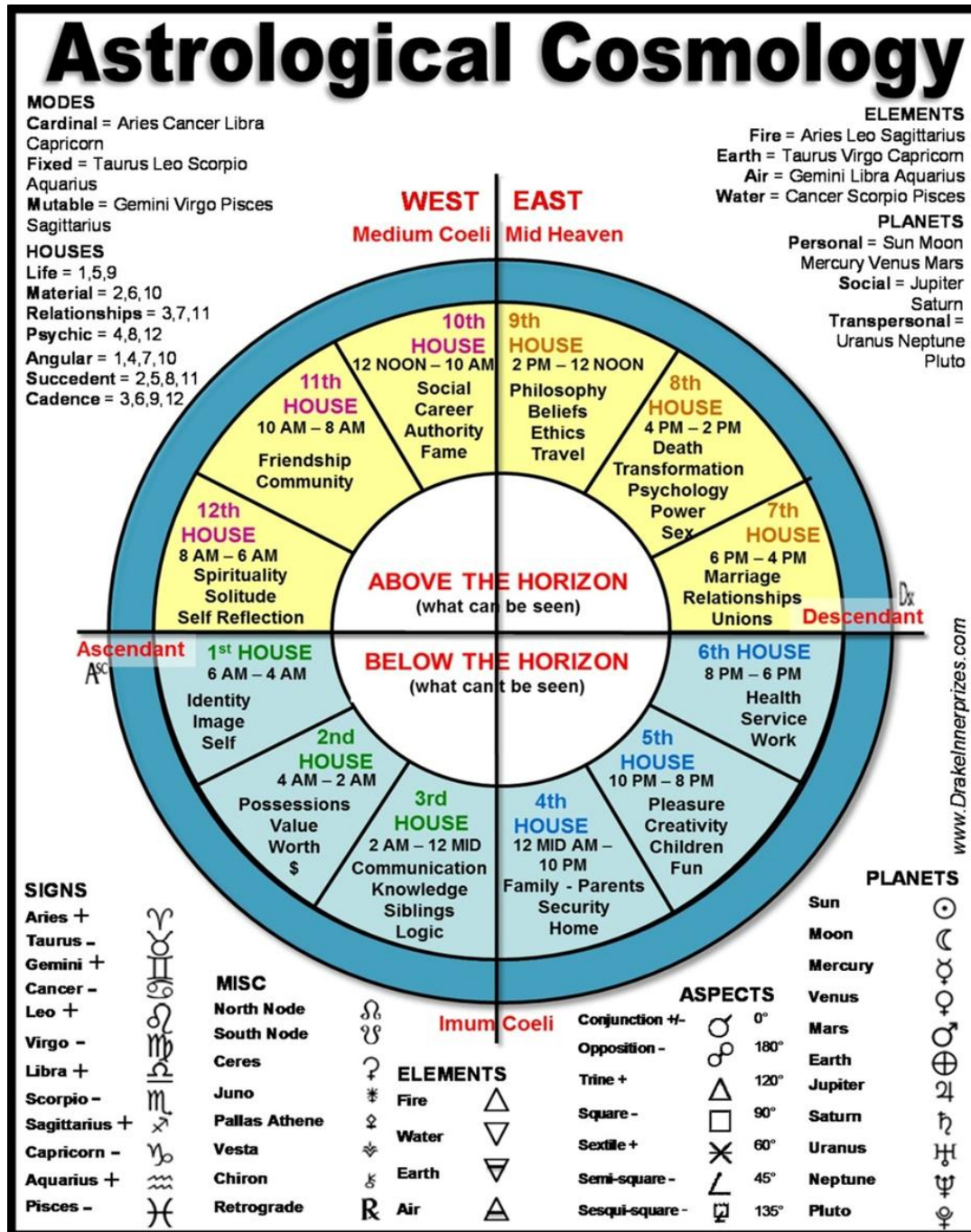

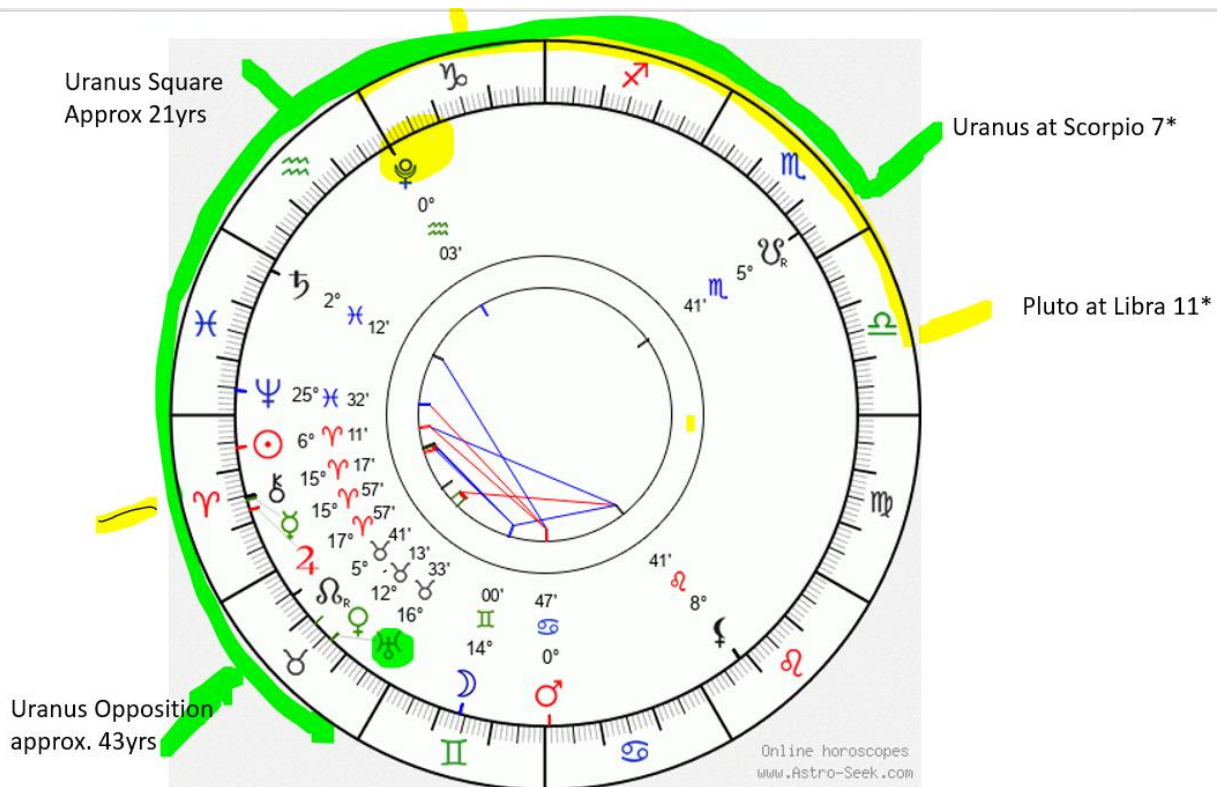


IMPORTANT TRANSITS

This is a visual way to start to see you Soul Journey in this lifetime.

Uranus has an 84 year cycle, and Saturn has a 28 year cycle.

It takes three complete Saturn cycles to equal one Uranus cycle.

Saturn transits each house or life issue every two and one-half years, while it takes Uranus seven years to move the same distance. In seven years, therefore, Uranus has moved through one house and Saturn, three.

Soul Based Life * Working with Your Transits

Saturn squares each seven years have major influence on your life. Saturn archetypically induces structural reality stress to itself every 7 years: The amount it takes to move one quarter of the wheel. - 7, 14, 21, **28**, 35, 42, 49, **56**, 63, 70, 77 & **84**.

Uranus induces the need to be free from that which is, the freedom from the known, at 21, 42, 63, & 84

The Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus and Mars are inner planets and move quickly through the chart. They reflect the internal day to day growth and process that we are feeling and working with. They are referred to as the inner planets and interpersonal.

Use these to help develop yourself and the YOU that you truly choose to be.

Sun

Sun/Earth are the places we see the way to live our Radiance of our Destiny, the Super Hero Cape that our Soul can wear as the Highest potential of who what can step into being.

The sun moves approximately 1 degree per day. It takes 30 degrees to move from one sign to the next. This is how we map our Astrological Signs of the wheel.

Where the sun is influencing your chart will be the places that you will feel more radiance or rush of photonic light from. This can translate to feeling the impulse of what that energy is in your life as if it is yours. This is a powerful way to work with transit energy for all that we are manifesting and creating in our life.

The Sun will activate a Gene Key/Gate for approximately 5 to 6 days. The switching to the gate into the next energy are switch over days where you will feel the influence of change in your life. (all sign and gate transition points will create this energy for you) This is also a magical moment to harness energy. Most of us will not have time to focus right on these moments, but if you can know the days when gates change, you can know those days are potentially amazing for initiating new energy in what every it is that you are doing.

A few powerful ways to work with the Sun are....

1. Notice when the Sun is transitioning over any of your birth planets. This can be times when they amplify in energy and you can harness that energy.
2. Pay attention to the Gene Keys/Gates transition days. (you can find this mapped on the calendar here <https://www.withbecca.com/events.html>)
3. Map when the Sun moves through the Quarters of the Rave Chart. (See image above)
4. Pull up the starseed connections chart and find what Star Races you might be illuminated by.
5. Spend time saying hello, connecting to the actual photons of the Sun and let the Solar Council directly connect with you.

MOON



Moon is the most conscious part of who we are. It is how WE see ourselves. It is where we seek for security and the realm of emotions in relationship to Venus (Feelings from a Higher Octave)

Is it in Cardinal, Fixed or Mutable? How open are we to leaning and expanding our emotional viewpoint in life?

Male or female

It takes 27 days, 7 hours, and 43 minutes for our Moon to complete one full orbit around Earth. This is called the sidereal month, and is measured by our Moon's position relative to distant "fixed" stars. However, **it takes our Moon about 29.5 days to complete one cycle of phases** (from new Moon to new Moon).

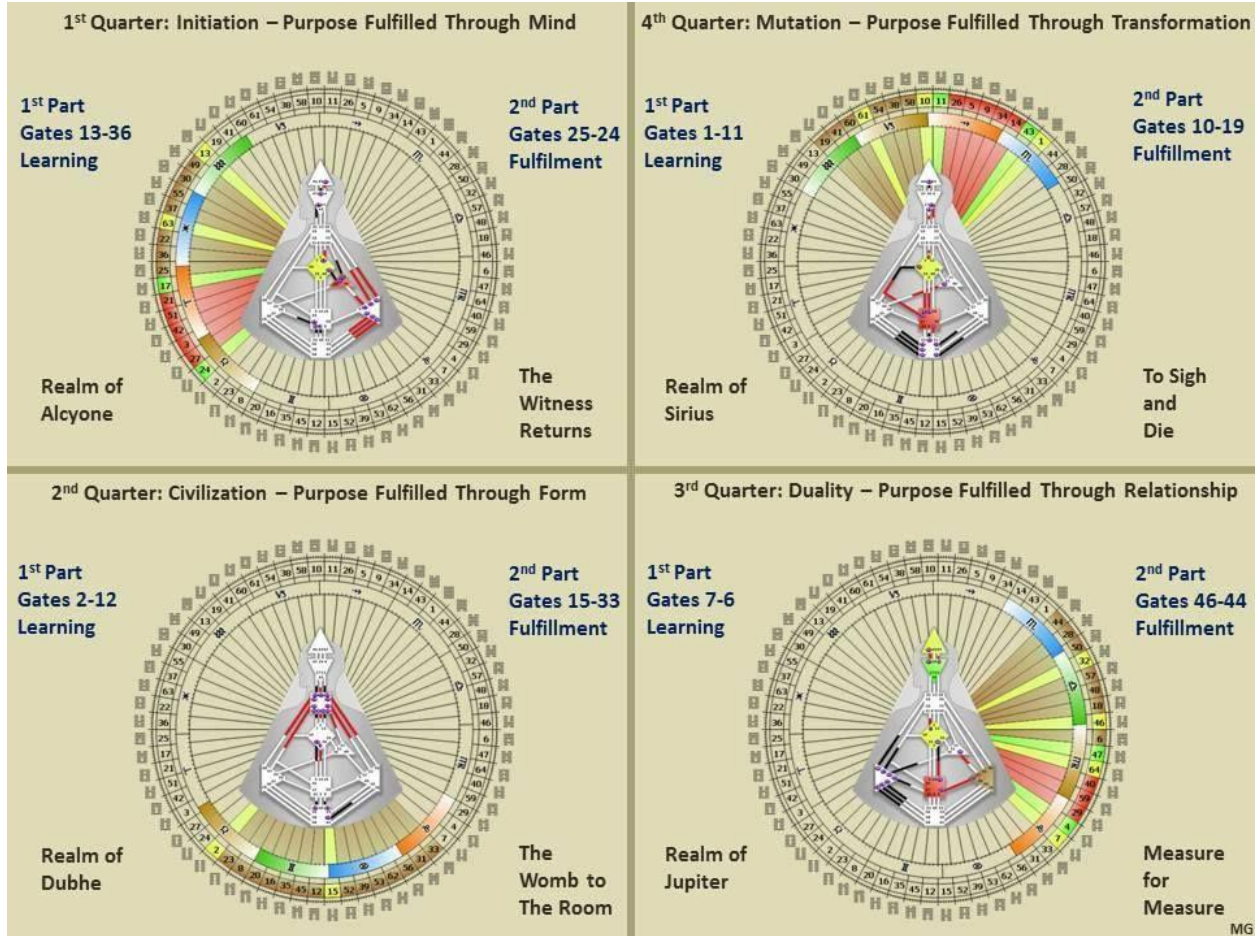
The moon moves approximately 12 degrees per day. This equals almost 3 Gene Keys/Gates per 1day.

Working with lunar energy is important, because as it transits through you chart, it adds to your ego journey. (Especially for Reflectors!)

A couple ways to work with the moon are ...

1. Through the phases of the moon from full moon to new moon to full moon again.
2. Through the phases of the quarters of the wheel. This can be done through the Human Design quarters of the Rave or the Quarters of the phases of Internal, to external to collective to spiritual. (Aries through to Pisces)

Soul Based Life * Working with Your Transits



This is very connected to the Nodes of the moon and to Venus. Moon is the direct reflection of the “feelings” of Venus, from an emotional more reactive and conscious perspective.

The moon will reflect to us the conscious identity of how we see ourselves personally, our ego.

It is a monthly journey as we explore all 64 gates and shadow/light from every possible aspect and explore the theme of our karmic story. Each lunar cycle we circle the karmic wheel and have the ability to bring awareness to our story. This is every changing. Like the skin of the snake, we are always in cycles of death and rebirth in our life as we transitions through our years and grow through our experiences.

Moon is Connected to the spiritual journey. It is related to Cancer in the 4th House and the journey is continued with Scorpio and Pisces. All three are Trine to each other.

Each phase of the moon has its own astrological energies and significance. Here is a brief overview:

1. New Moon: The New Moon is the beginning of the lunar cycle and represents new beginnings, fresh starts, and setting intentions. It is a time for planting seeds and starting new projects.

2. Waxing Crescent: As the moon begins to grow, the Waxing Crescent phase represents growth, expansion, and taking action towards our goals. This is a time to be proactive and take steps towards manifesting our intentions.

3. First Quarter: The First Quarter is a time of decision-making and taking action. It is a time to face challenges and make adjustments to our plans as necessary.

4. Waxing Gibbous: The Waxing Gibbous phase represents refinement and fine-tuning. It is a time to review our progress and make any necessary adjustments to our plans.

5. Full Moon: The Full Moon is a time of culmination and completion. It represents the peak of energy and emotion and is a time to release what no longer serves us.

6. Waning Gibbous: As the moon begins to wane, the Waning Gibbous phase represents gratitude and reflection. It is a time to express gratitude for what we have and to reflect on the lessons learned during the lunar cycle.

7. Last Quarter: The Last Quarter is a time of release and letting go. It is a time to release any negative patterns or habits and make space for new growth.

8. Waning Crescent: The Waning Crescent phase represents surrender and preparation for a new cycle. It is a time to rest, reflect, and prepare for the next lunar cycle.

This will show you all of your Lunar Returns for each month of the year. Your Lunar return is the time each month when you Moon is transiting exactly in the same position of the placement it was when you were born.

This is very significant for following your own personal moon cycle and how you are handing your initial place your Soul was wanting to empower.

*(The moon is your place where you are seeking emotional security,
Are you becoming self-empowered?)*

Below are some possibilities for your Moon Placement Story.

1st House/Aries/Mars

The emotional need to be validated on a personal level for one's own accomplishments, outward appearance, and actions that reflect one's own independence. The emotional desire would be to feel secure through the validation of others honoring and acknowledging one's accomplishments and physical self.

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a strong willed, assertive and direct soul. Forthrightness and independence are important to you in your moment to moment reality. You would likely be a person who enjoys leadership.

From a Soul Centered Perspective this is a placement of great activity. The soul level purpose is to re-orientate the emotions so that they can serve a higher purpose and good in physical form. Aries is an energy of learning, creating and knowing self, when you move out of the Ego, the soul can then find great joy in being in a physical form as a container to hold the will of the Infinite Intelligence of the Universe. What you put your energy and creative manifestation into, can then be the proper vehicle for the birth place of new ideas.

2nd House/Taurus/Venus

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a soul with a strong value system who will always be able to identify what resources are available in every moment of your reality. You are likely to have a stable self-worth and be strongly attracted to money in one way or another. You will always strive for self-reliance and self-sufficiency.

From a Soul Centered perspective, one takes on the ability to create any form of manifestation required for the fulfillment of one's life. When one is fully in alignment with the purpose of the Soul, the drive inside would be to serve humanity through the creation and nurturing that this placement brings. As with all desires of the Soul, your desire will be grounded in the path of serving the divine plan of the Infinite Creator.

3rd House/Gemini/Mercury

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a curious, knowledge seeking and diverse soul who will always be exploring the wonders of life. You are likely to be a great communicator and very logically orientated by nature.

From a Soul Centered perspective, Moon in Gemini creates an energy for focusing communication on Harmony in order to help guide and inspire Humanities relations with each other. This placement helps create a healing cycle through communication by either breaking down old outworn models of social interaction, or building new bridges of original interactions. How you inspire this communication will be based on the house placement of your moon.

4th House/Cancer/Moon

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a soft, sensitive, nurturing soul who prioritizes safety and security. You are likely to have a strong need for belonging and connectedness. Your home is your castle and your family the most important people in your life.

From a Soul Centered perspective, this calls one to move away from the past. The personality may want to draw on the past for safety and nurturing, but the Soul will draw one away from inwardly needing security, and inspiring one to foster social opportunities to assist humanity. This is a path of moving away from personal needs and demands to the universal purposes that can better serve the divine cosmic plan.

5th House/Leo/Sun

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a self-expressive, creative, playful soul who enjoys spontaneity and not to forget, being the center of attention. You are likely to enjoy a party more than most and especially...your birthday. You are the adult who never grows up and that's why children love you.

From a Soul Centered perspective, the goal of Moon in Leo is to move away from the Ego based emotions and to transform ones' life as an expression of inspiration for group consciousness. In this way your own personal talents and gifts become a way to help the whole. This allows for your creative energy to really shine and this light becomes a guide for others. How you shine this light will be from the house placement of your Moon.

6th House/Virgo/Mercury

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as perfection seeking and critical but all for the betterment of yourself and the world around you. You love to be of service to others and are likely to find great joy in healing, mentoring, exploring different ways of doing things and being dutiful.

From a Soul Centered perspective, your Soul is geared towards world service. You are here to reveal the purpose and function of Love within all forms. This path will be a path of devotion to service as the inner Christos mission to help unite humanity and all sentient life on Earth. The goal being the elevation of mass consciousness.

7th House/Libra/Venus

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a fairness seeking, harmonious soul who is working to create balance in the world. You are likely to be seeking your soulmate as you will feel incomplete without a balanced relationship. You have a strong awareness of others and their realities.

From a Soul Centered perspective, Libra brings the balance of the mind to one's life path. It helps one to focus in the places where the divine will is guiding to one to go. This allows for the externalization of the Divine Ideas for the unfoldment of the plan of creation into the minds of humanity. With you Moon in Libra, you will be a vessel for the birthing of new ideas through your emotional connections to others and to life.

8th House/Scorpio/Pluto

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as a truth seeking, intense soul who is wanting deep honesty, yearning for trust and psychological truth. You are likely to be attracted to empowering ideas and you can easily identify your own, as well as others, weaknesses.

From a Soul Centered perspective Scorpio allows the ego to dissipate as the form becomes the life expression for the healing properties of the Higher Self. This growth and expansion will come from trials that create crisis in life, that when overcome, will empower the path of the Soul. The house position of the moon is the places where these life upsets will come about.

9th House/Sagittarius/Jupiter

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as an explorer of universal truth, searching for expanding ideas and understanding things intuitively. You are seeking answers to the big questions in life. You are a natural philosopher.

From a Soul Centered perspective, one is finding one's own security in self through the expansion of form and desire and through the physical senses. This is where, from an ego base, one is learning what feels safe and not safe in our physical world. When you have reached a place of feeling this security inside yourself, you are truly the vessel for your soul's path of being a guiding awareness for humanity and the knowing of how to sustain humanity's well-being. This security comes from your higher knowing that you are more than your body, you are an eternal soul, so what you focus on will be the higher truths.

10th House/Capricorn/Saturn

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as an authoritative, mature, respectful soul who will always be hard working and responsible. You are likely to be very ambitious with a strong drive for the resulting respect and recognition.

From the Soul centered perspective this position for your moon can be challenging. As you evolve, you will find yourself overcoming the power of the material realm. This means that it will have less and less control over you as you surrender to your Soul's journey. When all material attachment ceases, and one moves on to the various initiations of spirit you find yourself balancing the two extremes. Having your moon in Capricorn means you are here to awaken awareness of the dualistic nature of this reality and create the resources necessary in order for divine consciousness to flow through you as a vessel in creating a harmonious world.

11th House/Aquarius/Uranus

With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as an innovative, future orientated thinker who demands individuation. You are likely to have a desire to de condition the rigid structures within our reality. You require individuality and freedom in every moment of your reality. It is important to you to have like-minded souls in your life.

From a Soul Centered perspective this is a beautiful placement for the moon because it lends itself to easily help one to transition from the overwhelm of emotions and to be able to focus deeply into the world of the service of the Soul. This helps to unravel the karmic patterns in one's life through detachment, while opening the heart to love from an unconditional state of connection to Source.

12th House/Pisces/Neptune

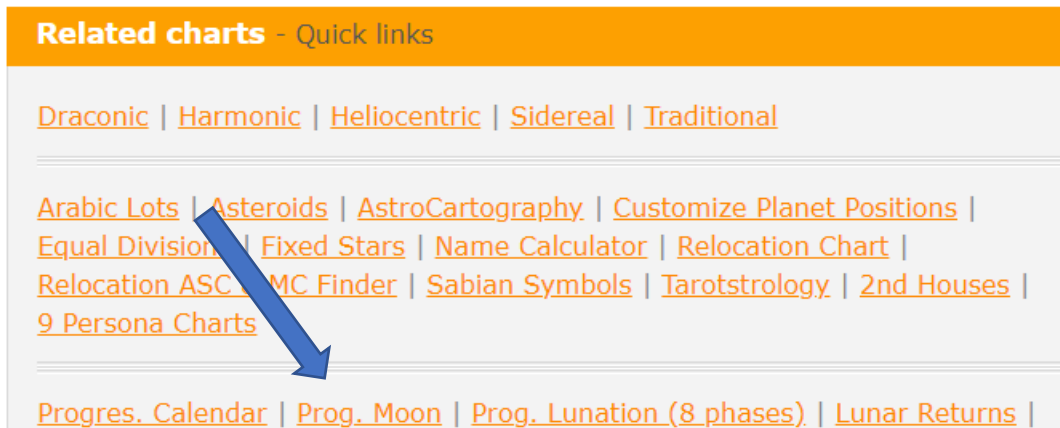
With the placement of the moon here, you inwardly identify yourself as an extremely sensitive, all loving soul who can connect to anything and anyone. You are likely to be forgetful and somewhat spacy and you will be naturally drawn to altered states of conscious. You naturally understand the importance of flowing with and surrendering to the greater reality. There can be an alienation factor and feeling that one has to supply one own needs.

The Soul Level Purpose of your Moon in Pisces is to harness the Will in order to activate the Soul's plan of Love/Wisdom, through never ending compassion and devotion. The work of a person with this position, would first of all, be to break one's attachment to the thrill of emotional sensation and stimulation. Then from here, the life path can be used to integrate and distribute a new energy toward developing and sharing universal compassion and understanding.

Progressed Moon

Progressed planets can indicate periods of change and transition in our lives. By paying attention to the timing of progressed planets, we can prepare for these changes and make the most of the opportunities they bring.

The Moon is the fastest moving “planet”, so it follows that the Progressed Moon is the fastest moving progressed planet. Because the Progressed Moon moves at an approximate rate of 12 degrees per year, it passes through a zodiac sign for approximately 2-1/2 years.

These 2-1/2 year periods show us attitude shifts in our lives. The current sign of the Progressed Moon shows us the energies that we are drawn to at that point in time.

Because zodiac signs move from masculine to feminine to masculine, and so forth, every 2-1/2 years (approximately), our energies tend to shift from outward to inward to outward again.

Progressed Moon in Aries

The focus at this phase of life is on outward-oriented energy and action. We look for direct confrontations, challenges, and stimulation during this period of our lives. We have newfound courage. We focus on new beginnings, fresh starts, and new projects, because we now feel motivated in these directions.

Progressed Moon in Taurus

While in Aries, we welcomed change and action. When the Progressed Moon changes signs to Taurus, we slow down and seek out some security in our lives. This marks a less impatient and competitive period of our lives. We don't look for new experiences as much as we manage our lives in a more solid, secure manner. We value predictability during this period.

Progressed Moon in Gemini

While in Taurus, we don't feel much need for learning new things. When the Progressed Moon shifts signs to Gemini, however, curiosity is ignited. We need to communicate with others, we need doors to open for us, we explore our little worlds and reach out to others. New friendships are often made during this markedly more sociable and busy period in our lives.

Progressed Moon in Cancer

This marks a time when we need the comforts of a home base. While the Progressed Moon moves through Cancer, we turn inward and focus on building or solidifying our home base and our families. We have a greater need for security and the feeling of being safe and comfortable during this period. This is a time for building your sense of security.

Progressed Moon in Leo

From the security and safety of the Progressed Moon in Cancer phase comes a desire for self-expression. Energies are directed outwards as we feel more confident moving about in the world, and we have a greater need to be heard, seen, and noticed. An increased desire to create, and to display our talents is often experienced during this phase.

Progressed Moon in Virgo

After a somewhat naive and playful period while the Progressed Moon moved through Leo, this phase indicates a need and/or desire to perfect our craft. This is a time of dedication to work, health, and routine. This is a more introverted period in your life when you might have your “nose to the grindstone”, so to speak.

Progressed Moon in Libra

The focus turns outward again as the Progressed Moon moves from the introverted Virgo to sociable Libra. An increased need to be with people, to socialize, and to compromise are featured during this period of life. More attention to physical appearance and attractiveness, as well as graciousness, is often prominent.

Progressed Moon in Scorpio

There can be a hunger now for deeper experiences and more powerful bonds. Emotional commitments come into focus. While the Progressed Moon was in Libra, harmony was most important to you. At this time, however, harmony might take a back seat as you feel the need for something more powerful and significant in your life.

Progressed Moon in Sagittarius

Freedom on all levels is the focus while the Progressed Moon is in Sagittarius — not only physical freedom of movement and expression, but mental and spiritual freedom as well. The emotional need during this period of your life is for expansion and growth. You do not want to be limited by boundaries or barriers. This is a more gregarious position of the Progressed Moon. Independence, new experiences, and intellectual growth are the focus.

Progressed Moon in Capricorn

The Progressed Moon in Capricorn shifts the attention to approval and recognition. The focus is on establishing some sort of order and control in your life. A stronger need for recognition and for concrete success is typical of this Progressed Moon phase.

Progressed Moon in Aquarius

This is a more sociable and gregarious position of the Progressed Moon. Stronger social awareness and a desire to belong to a group is present at this period in your life, although sometimes it's more about expressing your own individuality and breaking the rules. Networking is the keyword for this period.

Progressed Moon in Pisces

Heightened sensitivity and an emotional need to connect with your inner world is dominant during this period. This is often a more introverted period in your life when the focus is on your dreams and longings, personal creativity, and sensitivity.

Mercury

Mercury is the lower octave of Uranus and is the place that our brain thinks about and processes the projections of the Moon, Pluto/SN for evolutionary purposes. Mercury is how we see and label the world around us.

Mercury helps us feel safe by labeling the world around us so that we can create a syntax. Or intellectual structure to the world around us. You need to look at the Core Pluto/SN theme in order to ask why the Soul chose Mercury in this house and sign for projected thinking and acquiring knowledge in this lifetime. Left Brain. Rational thinking. Intellectual organization of our reality around us. A way of identifying phenomenal reality in order to support it's evolutionary intention.

The placement of our Mercury will also show us what we are needing to figure out from past lives. What we are trying to figure out and process through our mind. So, lives of massive betrayal, might choose Scorpio Mercury in this lifetime. When one can then process this information, the path of the Soul would be to then expand the perception of Mercury through the Expansion of Uranus into higher thinking, higher mind.

After the Moon, Mercury is the next fastest moving body that moves around our chart. It moves around the Sun in only 88 days. But, because of the retrogrades, it only moves around the astrological wheel **approximately every 12 months**.

Your mercury return is an impactful time to be aware of your thoughts and may be a time of new impactful ideas and an influx of logic toward decision making.

This is one of the most sporadic planets, orbit wise and with its retrogrades. In a year we can have four mercury retrograde periods.

This shows us the fluctuations that we have in our mind and thoughts. Mercury represents the denser vibration of Uranus. Uranus again, is a planet that wants to break Saturn out of its containment. So imagine Mercury as being in service to either the lower dominating forces of Saturn, or Freed to be the direct source of Communication from our Uranus. This would be similar to channeling your Higher Self.

Mercury is another planet that we can see the influence of the progressed Mercury in our Chart. The best way to work with progressed Mercury in your astrological sign is to focus on improving your communication skills and intellectual abilities. This can be done through reading, studying, writing, and having conversations with people who challenge your ideas. Pay

attention to the way you communicate and strive to be clear, concise, and articulate. You may also find that your thinking becomes more analytical and objective during this time, so it's a good idea to use these skills in decision-making and problem-solving. Additionally, pay attention to the house and aspects of your progressed Mercury, as these will provide more specific insights into how you can work with this energy.

Working with transiting Mercury through the houses can help you understand how your communication and thinking processes are being influenced by the current astrological climate. Transiting Mercury indicates a time of intellectual and communicative growth that can lead to personal evolution. Here are a few tips for working with Mercury as it transits through each house:

1st House: Focus on personal expression and self-promotion. Use this time to communicate your ideas and opinions to others. Pay attention to your thoughts and how you communicate with others. This is a time to work on expressing yourself authentically and with clarity.

2nd House: Focus on your values and how you communicate them to others. Concentrate on financial matters, budgeting, and planning. This is a good time to communicate with banks and financial advisors. This is a good time to work on financial planning and budgeting.

3rd House: Emphasize communication, learning, and networking. This is a good time to take classes, attend workshops, and build relationships with people in your field. Concentrate on learning and communication. Use this time to expand your knowledge and share your ideas with others.

4th House: Focus on family and home life. Use this time to communicate with family members and work on home improvement projects.

5th House: Emphasize creativity and self-expression. This is a good time to work on artistic projects and communicate your ideas to others.

6th House: Concentrate on health and work-related matters. Use this time to communicate with coworkers and focus on your physical health.

7th House: Focus on partnerships and relationships. This is a good time to communicate with your significant other, business partners, or clients.

8th House: Emphasize transformation and sexuality. Use this time to communicate with others about deep, meaningful topics.

9th House: Concentrate on spirituality and travel. This is a good time to communicate with

people from other cultures and explore your own spiritual beliefs.

10th House: Focus on career and public life. Use this time to communicate with your boss or coworkers and focus on professional goals.

11th House: Emphasize community and social networks. This is a good time to communicate with friends and join social or political groups.

12th House: Concentrate on spirituality and introspection. Use this time to reflect on your inner world and communicate with mentors or spiritual advisors.

Venus

Our Venus placement in our birth chart is the place where we can tap into the psychology of how we “hear others”. It holds the clues to our values (and insecurities) of the past/past lives, where we created opinions (values) of what we felt we needed to feel _____ (you fill in the blank) wanted, loved, safe, heard, valued, fed, warm, etc.

It is connected to Taurus (inner values/self needs) and Libra (outer values/needs from others)

This is the place we will most feel “my needs are not met”

Venus represents the principle of attraction, beauty, love and harmony. It is associated with our romantic desires, personal values, artistic expression, and our ability to form intimate relationships with others.

Venus also represents our capacity for appreciation and enjoyment of life. This principle helps us to develop gentleness, expressiveness, creativity and a deep sense of inner peace. However, Venus also has a shadow side, which can create issues around attachment, materialism, and a tendency to seek validation in external sources.

The placement of Venus and its aspects can reveal important information about a person's past-life relational patterns and emotional patterns. By working with these energies, individuals can learn to create more authentic and fulfilling relationships in the present.

Connecting and working with your Type, Strategy and Inner Authority will help you to fully come into balance with how you are in relationship to all in life.

The Venus cycle is another one that has variables to it depending on the retrogrades it experiences. This cycle can be **approximately 13 months for a Venus return.**

This is another planet that it makes no sense why it takes longer for the Return than for the cycle it takes around the Sun. It takes approximately 225 days for Venus to move around the Sun.

As you follow the transits, look to your Venus return as a time that you are expanding the way that you are nurturing and receiving.

Venus helps us witness how well we are “listening” to others around us based on what it is we want to hear. (what we want from our relationships)

If there are challenges, it is highly beneficial to see where you might be projecting your desires or values onto another. Venus teaches us our Dark and our Light side. If we start to tell stories about others in the relationships we are in (ie. Judge, gossip, validate our own point of view), then more than likely we are living in our own dream bubble and not really paying attention to our expectations and projections.

Venus Star Point

This myth is story of the cycle of Venus in the sky from Morning Star to Evening Star. Venus is the brightest light in our Night Sky and as we watch her journey, she disappears from view when she becomes conjunct with the Sun.

This is a shamanic journey into the underworld.

One Sun Cycle of Venus Star Point to Venus Star Point is 584 Days (1.6 yr) Phi Ratio to the Earth Cycle of the Sun

One Complete VSP Cycle around the 12 Signs = 8yrs

She then spends approximately 260 days, or seven lunar cycles in the east before descending beneath the horizon for approximately 60 days where she forms an exterior conjunction with the sun.

This 60-day period when Venus is too close to the sun to be observed is likened to her being in the underworld.

She then rises in the west for another approximate 260 days or 7 lunar cycles before returning to the underworld for a short 0-20 days

This is the Death and Rebirth of Inanna

Mars

Mars is the Lower Octave of Pluto, it is the place where we exert our Power/Desires into the physical world.

As it moves through each house, it gives us the charge of energy into that house to exert our desires and power through that house.

It is a motivating energy that can either create re-actions that we will then have to “put out the fire”, or the creative burst of energy to get things going. When we are closely aligned to our Type, Strategy and Inner Authority, we will be at a greater advantage of being mindful with the impulses and keeping the energy flowing where it is best serving our Soul/Higher Self.

Mars is often seen as the planet of desire, passion, energy, drive, and action. It's associated with our ability to assert ourselves in the world, to fight for what we want, and to take risks.

In the birth chart, the placement of Mars and the aspects it makes to other planets can reveal a lot about our motivations, our approach to conflict, and our ability to go after what we want in life. For example, a strong Mars may indicate someone who is assertive, confident, and willing to take risks, while a more challenging Mars placement may indicate someone who struggles with anger, aggression, or a lack of energy and motivation.

Mars is also associated with the concept of "right use of will." This means that we must learn to use our Mars energy in a way that is aligned with our soul's purpose and evolution. This can be easier said than done, as our personal desires and the collective demands of society can often be in conflict with our deeper spiritual goals.

It takes Mars approximately 2 years to return to your natal position. You get the experience of a Mars return every two years of your life, meaning you feel a pretty consistent change with the focus of your energy, giving you the opportunity to round out your desires and power around the wheel in a conscious way should you choose.

Mars moves from house to house in 1 ½ to 2 months time. Knowing where your Mars is during this time is very helpful. This can show you what area of your life you might be more focused on and where you can work with the movement the Mars offers.

Mars retrogrades happen about once a year, this is a time to reflect inward on how you are using your power and to self assess in an honest way your desires you are wanting enact and how are you using your will.

Jupiter

Jupiter is where we want to start expanding of expression of “what is....” What is god, the universe, our beliefs, the nature of reality or creation. It want to start expanding to the bigger questions of who we are in the universe.

This expansion can be in thought or study, or through actual travel. Jupiter is very Right Brained. It many times shows past lives in opposite situations, opposite cultures, beliefs, religions, countries, etc

It is the place that we have come to GROW!

The influence of Jupiter in our lives is related to our spiritual growth and expansion. Jupiter represents our beliefs, values, and sense of purpose, as well as our ability to experience abundance and joy.

In past lives, we may have developed limiting beliefs or negative attitudes towards growth and expansion, which can manifest as challenges related to Jupiter in our current life. May 16/17, 2023 Jupiter is changing on the from its Year in Aries into Taurus. It will remain here until May 25/26 of 2024 before moving into Gemini.

Saturn

March 7/8, 2023 Saturn Moved into Pisces for the year. It takes Saturn 28/29 years to move around the wheel. It stays in each sign for approximately 2 ½ yrs.

It is going to stay in Pisces Energy until February 14/15 of 2026

On correlates with the type of society slash country so the soul has determined to be born into in order to be exposed to the nature of those social realities social conventions social customs social taboos social norms and social procedures of all kinds and how this serves as a conditioning factor to consciousness itself are these positioning factors are necessary in the point of view of the souls evolution again why is this one important to Tibet and this one into Russian just so we have to again go back to the famous political bottom line why this country so Saturn has this linkage and has Saturn is serving as the conditioning to consciousness from this point of view from another point of view it has everything to do with this structure of consciousness itself I think of it from the point of view

Saturn helps us question our conditioning from the past. It is the place where we test our Maturity and responsibility in what we have received.

Saturn's influence can bring maturity, wisdom, and a deep sense of purpose, as well as a desire for achievement and recognition. However, when Saturn is poorly integrated or in a difficult aspect, it can also lead to fear, depression, and a sense of being trapped or oppressed.

The house that our Saturn is in we will generally accept as is. At 14 during the opposition, is when we first start to challenge and explore the polarity.

As Saturn moves through all the houses, it is our chance to develop our level of maturity in each of these areas of our life.

Saturn is where we develop our psychological growth and the map of Saturn around our own personal astrological wheel shows us our own personal journey through this maturation.

When Saturn transitions from one house to the next you can see this as a crossroads. This can be when major things happen or occur in one's life. This is different than when Saturn moves from one sign to the next. Because that is affecting all of humanity.

For instance, Saturn just moved into Pisces and will be there until February of 2026. That is a psychological influence that is affecting all of humanity. But when Saturn moves from one house to the next within your own house alignments in your astrological wheel these are significant markers for you personally.

Saturn is where we have come to learn our power and structure in our life. It is the area in our life that we as a soul are primarily focusing our maturity and learning to master the balance of the house of our Saturn.

The cycle of Saturn is one of the most important cycles in our life for the development of our conscious maturity and our ability to cognitively determine the rules and structure we live by.

The house of our Birth Saturn is our main theme of our life. It is symbolized by our past life experiences and will be directly pointing to what the Soul is wanting us to break free from and recreate in a higher way.

Saturn has a direct relationship with Uranus.

When Saturn reaches its first Square, our Uranus will also be moving into a new sign/house.

When Saturn is at its First opposition at 14, Uranus has moved approx. 2 signs or houses. Showing an additional energy to our unique Saturn Opposition.

At 21 Saturn is $\frac{3}{4}$ around the Wheel and moving into its final quarter before the 1st Saturn Return. Uranus Square is right at this time, giving a push to really maturing with what Saturn is teaching us.

Saturn in our lives is related to our karmic patterns and lessons. Saturn represents the limitations, challenges, and responsibilities that we encounter in our lives, as well as our ability to overcome them and grow in the process.

Saturn's influence can be related to past life experiences where we may have neglected our responsibilities or failed to learn important lessons. Therefore, in this life, Saturn's influence can manifest as obstacles or delays that force us to confront our limitations and take responsibility for our actions.

However, by embracing the positive qualities of Saturn, such as discipline, hard work, and perseverance, we can overcome these challenges and achieve success in our endeavors. Who is Saturn?

Saturn was the youngest of the seven Titans the earth born Sons of Uranus.

The legend and story of Saturn shows us the primordial conflict between structure and creativity. Saturn and Uranus.

According to the myth, Uranus was the son and husband of Gaia, the Earth Goddess. He was known as the god of the sky and the father of the Titans, including Cronus (Saturn) and Rhea. In some versions of the myth, Uranus was overthrown by his son Cronus, who castrated him with a sickle and took his place as ruler of the gods. The myth of Uranus and his family was an important part of ancient Greek religion and is still studied and discussed today.

In Greek mythology, the Titans were the children of Uranus (God of the sky) and Gaia (Goddess of the earth) and were known as powerful, primordial deities who ruled the world before the Olympian gods. The Titans were often depicted as giant beings, similar in appearance to man but with incredible strength, intelligence, and longevity. There were twelve main Titans in Greek mythology. they were:

1. Cronus: the God of Time and the most powerful of the Titans.
2. Oceanus: the God of the Oceans and waterways.
3. Hyperion: the God of Light and father of the sun, the moon, and the dawn.
4. Themis: the Goddess of Justice.
5. Iapetus: the God of Mortality and ancestor of the human race.
6. Atlas: the God who held the world on his shoulders as punishment for siding with Cronus in his war against the Olympians.
7. Coeus: the God of Intellect and celestial navigation.
8. Rhea: the Goddess of Motherhood, sister, and wife of Cronus.
9. Tethys: the Goddess of Fresh Water and one of the wives of Oceanus.
10. Mnemosyne: the Goddess of Memory.
11. Phoebe: the Goddess of Prophecy and grandmother of Apollo and Artemis.
12. Thea: the Goddess of Light and mother of Helios, Selene, and Eos.

The Titans were eventually defeated by the Olympian gods in a decade-long struggle known as the Titanomachy, and were imprisoned in Tartarus, a place in the underworld, while the Olympians took control of the world.

Saturn also has an orbit through the Zodiac that signifies multiple different cycles that we can grow from. There is the more popular ones that we know of such as the saturn return and second saturn return. But there are also the quarters of Saturn as Saturn moves from quarter to quarter around the wheel.

The best way to map these locations of zero degrees 90 degrees 180 degrees 90 degrees 0 degrees. This would be if you took the wheel of your astrological chart, Find your Natal Saturn (3 o'clock) then mark your Saturn opposition (9 o'clock). Imagine these would be 9:00 o'clock and 3:00 o'clock then find your 90 degrees on the top and bottom as if you are marking a cross on your astrological wheel for the 12:00 o'clock and 6:00 o'clock positions.

You will have to use your imagination for this because nothing will be it exactly those positions on your chart but you are just creating a perfect cross based on your Natal Saturn position

1st House/Aries/Mars

The emotional need to be validated on a personal level for one's own accomplishments, outward appearance, and actions that reflect one's own independence. the emotional desire would be to feel secure through the validation of others honoring and acknowledging one's accomplishments and physical self.

This is the place where you will pursue your curiosities. You will want to expand yourself the idea of "I".

One would ask am I fully into myself, or am I forgetting to relate to others. This is the place of developing the self. This is the foundational house of know thyself, and its polarity of the 7th house then expands to I am you, and you are me.

Who did you come into this life to be, and are you willing to live it in a balanced way in order to be that gift for others?

2nd House/Taurus/Venus

Saturn in the second house can create I structured consciousness around the need for material. it is the place where we now start to ground into the world around us. This might be a time of wanting to study new interests, get involved in new things. Get anchored in to society. This is the place where we start to invest in the world around us and hang on to that which we feel will propel us in our desires based on security and safety.

This is the place where we need to ask what our are ethical awarenesses of how we are utilizing the material realm and how we are using the world around us for our development. This is the House of hanging on to whereas its polarity would be the 8th House of letting go. Here we want to ask are we over focused on what it is we need, or are we aware of responsibly utilizing the resources of the earth. Are we trusting that we will always have what we need. And aware of where desire might actually be causing harm to another.

- A sense of responsibility and duty towards one's own financial security and stability. Saturn in the 2nd house may bring a serious and practical approach to money management and savings, as well as a long-term perspective on investments and resources.
- Challenges or delays related to earning money or building wealth, which may require hard work, patience, and persistence. Saturn in the 2nd house may bring obstacles or limitations in the area of income, but also the potential for steady and sustainable growth over time.
- A strong attachment to material possessions, which may reflect a sense of self-worth and security. However, Saturn in the 2nd house may also bring a fear of loss or scarcity, leading to a tendency to hoard or cling to things.

3rd House/Gemini/Mercury

This is through communication, learning, socializing. There can be such a quick energy within this that the mind will be looking for something solid to believe in. This would be the place where we begin to enter into the programs or path that is mapped out or structured for us.

The polarity of this house is seeking spirituality and the spirit realms to be ungrounded. This is where we want to ask are we so hooked on our technology, are to do lists and the drama of the story around us, or have we taken time for mystical thoughts and connection to realms beyond.

4th House/Cancer/Moon

This is the place where you truly began to explore our feelings and our inner knowing. A place where we connect to home and how comfortable we feel with ourselves. This can be the place of deep subconscious. One of the places of our shadows. 4th house and 10th house are unique in that they also hold patterns and akashik memories of our ancestors, our family line, and the nurturing we do or don't feel from our mother and father.

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Here we are learning to develop our emotions and find our potential and feel confident enough to receive the support of others as we have courage to take our potential out into the world. This placement needs freedom to explore your own needs and to feel validated in expressing these needs.

This is one of the placements where we can feel the most disempowered. Disempowered internally and emotionally or disempowered in the world around us.

The challenge is to make sure am I being overly focused on me and my needs or am I being aware of how my actions are influencing others. Have I been so inwardly focused that I have forgotten to focus on creating stability through my confidence and power in the outside world. How am I balancing inward and outward power.

5th House/Leo/Sun

Now we are allowing ourselves to expand out into the community do you express desires and creativity. This is the place where Saturn begins to explore creativity, your own expressions and how you think you or what you are doing looks like to the rest of the world. This placement has been overly amplified by technology allowing us to have a feeling of a reality that looks good on the outside, Through social media, selfies and the way that we present ourselves to the world.

When Saturn is moving through this house we will need to have the freedom to explore maybe recreating ourself or showing ourself to the world in a new way period two unleash some creative ideas that we haven't had the freedom to express. This is the place where our inner child begins to be validated in the outside world as a valuable contributor to society.

We want to ask if we are focusing too much on ourself or are we using our gifts to uplift humanity. The polarity point is the 11th house and doing for others.

When Saturn crosses this house this can also be a time where we are thinking of Children, or giving birth to something new.

6th House/Virgo/Mercury

Saturn in the 6th house is where we start to grow up and get more serious. This is where we begin to analyze and focus on our decisions and become more present in the moment. This can be the place of beginning to think of more long term goals and responsibilities. This placement can also create a stress or anxiety of not feeling good enough or over analyzing and nitpicking ones actions in a desire for perfection.

This is the place of becoming so overly absorbed in one's work or responsibilities that we can forget to stop and really be present with our loved ones communicating with us. This deep

need for getting things right is still a personal need and is highly connected to validation and seeking validation outside of oneself.

The question for this placement is am I so absorbed in my world and my responsibilities that I have forgotten to find the mystical and spiritual meaning for my service? The polarity point of this house is the 12th house and the transcendence of getting too caught up in the physical world.

7th House/Libra/Venus

Now as we see Saturn in the trans personal houses, the structure of consciousness or beliefs begins to move outward an anchor into the thoughts and opinions of the world around. Here the focus is now in relating to another. Here one starts will not be as independent anymore and now be made based on what one's partner might actually want. This is the place where we can lose ourself and another and find ourselves not even knowing who we are because we have become so focused on someone else's beliefs or desires. with Saturn in the 7th house there may not even be a sense of "I", and regardless of what you might think you want there will be a underlining feeling of needing to think first of others.

this is the first place we are starting to learn to share our energy with others, and cocreate dreams and desires, but also to make sure that we are not getting lost as an individual in the relationship. And Saturn is moving through this house we may find ourselves reevaluating who we are in relationship with since they play such an integral role of where our energy is being directed.

8th House/Scorpio/Pluto

Oh this is the place of assessing resources and what is of most value to hold on to and what is at the place of time to let go. Here we began to truly evaluate what really matters. With Saturn in this house it is in an energy where the pool is taking it towards spirit, and getting to the bottom of what is truth. This house placement will begin to lighten the load of anything that is not truly integral for taking through the journey to spirit.

This placement will want to test everything and challenge all of the most forbidden things in order to know for oneself what is real and what is not. When Saturn moves through this house it can be a time of great changes. Anything we have been tolerating will be less likely to make it through this house if it is not align to our souls purpose.

Here we want to make sure are we just tossing things out because we are so immersed in the realms beyond, or are we truly balancing want to keep and want to let go of from higher mind.

- A serious and cautious approach to taboo subjects, such as death, sex, and the occult.

9th House/Sagittarius/Jupiter

When Saturn is in this placement we are now focused on our real purpose and importance for this existence. Here you will feel an ability to see things from a higher perspective and to really assess what is important. Your spirit wants to align with what you are creating and dreaming in your souls purpose

This is the place right before we truly bring into manifestation in the world that which we came to be. This is where we can begin to get disillusioned to the world. So it is important to make sure that we do not completely unplug from ordinary or physical reality. When Saturn is in this position it can desire to fly off into the imagination of expanded learning, contemplation, research, esoteric or spiritual realms. Here we will need to balance still taking care of the mundane reality and not forgetting to pay the bills.

10th House/Capricorn/Saturn

when Saturn is in the 10th house, you will find yourself experimenting with taking more personal power and taking big risks to garner new opportunities.

This is also the house & that saturn is most comfortable and so it is considered the golden position. The place where it's time for us to truly manifest in the world. Or you feel as though you are on fire and things are going your way. This is the time when your energy and aura is most radiant and truly attracts the attention of others. This could be a time of great shining or popularity.

10th and 4th house are unique in that they also hold patterns and Akashic memories of our ancestors, our family line, and the nurturing we do or don't feel from our mother and father.

Here we are learning to develop our emotions and find our potential and feel confident enough to express our power and potential out into the world. This placement needs confidence to explore your authority, and to feel validated in expressing these needs.

This is one of the placements where we can feel the most disempowered. Disempowered internally and emotionally or disempowered in the world around us.

11th House/Aquarius/Uranus

With our Saturn in this position in life we are now really expressing how we can be in service in a really big way. This is also a very comfortable place for Saturn because Saturn was also once the ruler of Aquarius.

Now One's focus and attention is turned outward in how to share your gifts and how will those gifts help humanity.

Here the question would be am I giving everything away, am I so overly focused on humanity and helping others that I am not paying any attention to my own needs or creativity?

Here it is important to remember to not become overrun by the uranian energy of shock and frantic Ness to fix things now for the world. The nervous system can become overwhelmed in this position feeling unable to be in service or fix all the things that you think you can. Ones viewpoint might become so preoccupied with what still needs to be corrected from your own viewpoint, that you forget to pay attention to what is beautiful creative happy and fun. With the polarity point being Leo or the 5th house, it's important to bring that childlike wonder and fun into all that we do.

12th House/Pisces/Neptune

Here, Saturn is potentially the most confused. If your Uranus is in retrograde you will have a much easier time dealing with this energy because you are already open to the fluidity of expanding the mind with no borders.

Saturn tends to like some sort of structure and here we are completely learning to let go. The energy of bliss. We are asked to really assess all the things we thought were so important, and can we reframe that importance to doing things just for the sheer bliss of participating in life, rather than the arduous structure of putting so much importance on the outward systems of why. This is one to truly meditate upon.

Here is where our consciousness can begin to merge with the consciousness of the all and have the perception in a small way of our eternal nature. The transcendence of the veil.

During transit times of Saturn through the 12th house, we are asked to observe are we checking out of this reality, allowing ourselves to become distracted in addictive or mindless

activities in order to not face the void. distractions can come in any form and truly be anything that we are overly obsessing or placing our attention into. The polarity point of this is the 6th house and becoming over identified with responsibilities. Addiction and distractions can come in any form, and we will know them generally because we will find ourselves defending why we are allowing them to take up our time.

Uranus

Uranus is the Higher Octave of Mercury, and is Directly connected to chasing and shattering Saturn. This is the planet of Transformation. The place where spirit breaks free from any structures or restraints that are outdated or do not flow with the harmony of the Soul.

When Uranus is in Retrograde, it opens the Door for Neptune

This is how our soul is breaking down the false that is in the way of transformation. It is the breaking down of our conditioning.

In human design, the experiment is all about deconditioning. Uranus is deconditioning at its' fullest expression.

The house that Uranus is in shows us our shadow, our past lives energy we came here to dissolve the delusion of, so we can embrace Source, which is right inside of us.

The house that Neptune is in shows us where we need to surrender, the house where Uranus is in where we need to break free.

Uranus shocks us, the revolutionary energy that helps us break down the false. Almost as if it holds a charge to it that electrocutes us if the energy it touches as it moves, does not resonate with our Soul Source truth.

We are hardwired to not feel comfortable with things (energy) that goes against Natural Law and Source of All that Is.

Uranus correlates to the hypothalamus. We all have one. It is located in the lower brain, in the back of the skull, and emits what are known as chemical messages which are impacting on the primary brain, the instinctual brain, which regulates all body functions like breathing, excreting, the sexual impulse to procreate the species, etc.

This is a visual way to start to see your Soul Journey in this lifetime.

Uranus will stay in one House for Approximately 7 years.

Uranus has an 84 year cycle, and Saturn has a 28 year cycle.

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It takes three complete Saturn cycles to equal one Uranus cycle.

Saturn transits each house or life issue every two and one-half years, **while it takes Uranus seven years to move the same distance. In seven years, therefore, Uranus has moved through one house and Saturn, three.**

Saturn squares each seven years have major influence on your life. Saturn archetypically induces structural reality stress to itself every 7 years: The amount it takes to move one quarter of the wheel. - 7, 14, 21, **28**, 35, 42, 49, **56**, 63, 70, 77 & **84**.

Uranus induces the need to be free from that which is, the freedom from the known, at 21, 42, 63, & 84

Your Uranus Opposition will occur around the age of 42 to 44 yrs.

This is your Kundalini Awakening and can be seen as your "midlife crisis" The house of your Uranus, and Uranus Opposition show the places your are seeking freedom to be ALL of you. Any places you have been holding yourself back, or have not retrieved all the gifts from your shattered shadow self (traumatized inner child/soul retrieval), you may feel the rebellion acting out to be free.

Neptune

Neptune has a slow orbit around the astrological wheel, taking approximately 165 years to complete a full cycle. In astrology, Neptune is considered a generational planet, as its influence is felt more on a collective level rather than on an individual level.
